# THREE WORLD RECORDS SET AT 2013 JOGGLING CHAMPIONSHIPS

The 2013 IJA World Joggling Championships witnessed three world records. Eric Walter blasted the 23 year old 400 meter 3 ball record set by Owen Morse in 1990 at 57.3 seconds. Walter ran an incredible 1.5 seconds faster in 55.8 as he destroyed the field finishing 13 seconds ahead of the second place finisher.

Newcomer Gabrielle Foran established herself as one of the greatest female jogglers in history winning three events and setting a world record in the 1600 meter 3 ball as the first women to break the 6 minute barrier.

Former IJA Stage Champion Thomas Dietz took up joggling for the first time this year and came away with gold medals in both the 100 meter 5 ball and 100 meter 7 ball. In the latter event, Dietz broke the world record set last year by Jack Denger by over 5 seconds in a time of 53.6.

# Web Site Problems, by Don Lewis

You may have noticed that the IJA web site has been having some difficulties recently. The site has either been slow, completely unavailable, or full of broken links. Our webmaster, David Landowne has been working hard to make Juggle.org fully available.

The trouble seems to be a result of web crawlers, or bots, which want to suck up all the content that is available on our server. When you consider the photo galleries and videos that we host, that is a considerable amount of data. While we have not exceeded the bandwidth allowed on our Internet hosting account, the intensive cpu activity was causing problems on the server. Our hosting supplier, Westhost, had to disable our site temporarily to avoid impacting other clients

The IJA web site is back in business, although some parts of it may be inaccessible while the site's bot-proofing is beefed

up. It is a constant effort to keep ahead of problems like this that are imposed from without. Meanwhile, direct links to various functions do work even though the menu system may not offer the content. Disabling the menus is one of the temporary strategies used to frustrate the 'bots while working around the problem.

So if you go to juggle.org and see an "Apache is installed" page, or an under construction logo, it means that the site is up, but the direct menus are not available. This situation will probably be under control by the time you read this. We do know that it is a problem, and volunteers are working hard to get service back to normal.

# Why "Letters of Interest" this year? by Don Lewis

Unlike IJA Directors who are elected, IJA officers are volunteers who are appointed by the IJA Board. The reality usually is that there are generally just a few volunteers that regularly occupy these positions. In some ways, that is good because it provides a form of long term continuity.

In other ways it is not so good because other members who would like to get involved assume that they have no chance of scoring an interesting position. That makes it difficult for the Board members to know who else might be interested.

A lot of public Boards use this approach as a "best practice" to assure that the organization is staying up to date with the resources available to it.

Here is an example. The IJA has been publishing an enewsletter on a monthly basis for more than five years. currently as a pdf file attached to an email. In the past, the IJA has had printed newsletters sent by mail or as an insert to a printed magazine. Technology evolves. The IJA now

has an online magazine that has more content than we were ever able to publish in print, and new articles are added more often than in any magazines we published. We don't actually need two repositories of content, but we do want to communicate regularly with members. There are a variety of ways to communicate that are more efficient than mailing pdf files and that can facilitate outreach beyond existing IJA members.

It is a good bet that there are IJA members out there that are skilled in these new technologies and would really like to help pull the IJA forward.

Not everyone wants a job for life, so don't worry that you'll be insulting someone who has been doing a job "forever". Even if you don't want the responsibility of an official position, you might want to help move a project to the next level. Show some interest. We're eager to know your ideas.
