IJA Stage Championships

Top jugglers from around the world come to the IJA festival each year to present their skill and art in the IJA Stage Championships, hoping to earn the coveted IJA Gold Medal. Cash prizes and medals are awarded to the top three winners in the Juniors, Teams, and Individuals categories.

People interested in competing in the 2014 IJA Stage Championships will be required to submit a Prelim Video and \$25 entry fee, *no later than May 15th*. Full updated Championships rules and guidelines will be posted on the IJA website by Feb. 15th.

Website, Forums and Newsletters, by Don Lewis

We talk a lot about improving the IJA website. While the rest of us are talking, David Landowne (our webmaster) quietly goes ahead and starts moving us in the right direction while keeping our options open.

There are a lot of possibilities out there that include sophisticated **C**ustomer **R**elationship **M**anagement systems with built-in websites and communication tools. They are not cheap, but at least the fundamentals are maintained by the service providers. We may go that way some day, but in the mean time we have an existing site to maintain.

The IJA has had only a few iterations to its website over the years. Initially, Stuart Celarier, then Steve Salberg maintained a simple web presence. Martin Frost took that over and improved on it. Then Ron Harvey took over and partially implemented a new design created by Cynthia Rauschert, while Martin helped keep the old site up. Then Dave Davis and Joyce Howard brought the new look online, and that version is the basis of what we have now, though with many improvements by David Landowne.

Websites have a tendency to just grow in all directions with assortments of files proliferating in myriad directories. **C**ontent **M**anagement **S**ystems emerged to make it easier for webmasters to control the explosion of content in a coherent way. Recently, David has added the Drupal software to our server to improve things. Drupal is a popular open source CMS with a lot of extensions developed and maintained by other adherents.

New Forum Software

One feature is a sophisticated forum package that integrates well. You may have noticed recently that there is a new way to log into the IJA forum. We made your new forum username the same as your eJuggle username, namely your email address from the IJA membership database. However, those are two separate accounts, so the passwords to the two are independent -- changing one doesn't change the other. If you are unable to login to either, you can use the forum or eJuggle login page to request a new password, which will be emailed to you.

All of the old forums have been changed to read-only. The content is all there, right back to the earliest messages if you have the patience to read them.

eJuggle Updates

Each month the IJA's eNewsletter lists the titles of the latest articles that have been posted to eJuggle. Another way to be informed of new articles is the RSS feed from eJuggle. Unfortunately the ability to use an RSS feed has been bred out of many modern browsers. This useful feature now requires apps and extra steps to discover what is new.

One option we are looking at is to deliver a summary of the content to you as special type of email, similar to a newsletter, that contains a brief summary of each new article and a direct link to access it immediately. There are several inexpensive mail services available that integrate well with a WordPress eZine, such as Constant Contact and MailChimp.

The interesting part of using a third party service like that is that members can set their own subscriber preferences. We may be able to offer daily, weekly, or monthly digests of eJuggle content. Another nice benefit would be click thru statistics so that we get better data about what articles you find interesting.

Much of the eJuggle content is for members only, which requires a simple login. However, there is no reason that the entire world can't opt in to receive an email summary of what they are missing. We've never tried something like that before because it is just too much work for volunteers to try to maintain an opt-in mailing list as well as the membership list. A mail service can handle all that nearly automatically.

There is obviously a learning curve here, so if any of you have experience with this type of thing and are interested in being involved, please get in touch. Everything from technical expertise to cautionary tales will be of interest to us.

Turbo Fest 2014, by Don Lewis

TurboFest in Quebec City has become the preferred way for many jugglers to start the new year. And why not? This is one of the best festivals on the planet. The technical level is high, but there are plenty of opportunities for even beginning jugglers to advance quickly and have a good time.

The space is fabulous. On-site indoor camping, showers, and a snack bar make this festival convenient and affordable. The Turbo version of Renegade features live music in the main space. Workshops are spread throughout the facility, upstairs and down. Supper is ordered in from a local restaurant for those who don't want to miss a thing. By popular demand, one night featured poutine. The snack bar also doubled as a real bar serving locally micro-brewed beer.

The festival theme was SteamPunk, a wildly popular literary genre. The Friday Turbo Show featured costumed

automatons on stilts, complete with gears and steam pipes, working the crowd as the room filled up. The bilingual MC played the role of incomprehensibly brilliant and strange inventor/blacksmith. Those who didn't understand the steampunk references were somewhat lost in either language as a result. It was a great show of variety circus arts from Chinese pole to some very unusual box manipulation, along with some impressive juggling.

The Saturday show was held in a theatre at a college a few blocks away. The show featured the local group Les Parfaits Inconnus (The Perfect Strangers). They supplied a full hour of live music, acrobatics, juggling, magic, cycling, and clowning. A high energy show that was over all too soon.
