

#### **Travel Insurance for Healthcare**, by Don Lewis

It is a popular misconception that healthcare in Canada is free. It isn't. Healthcare is administered by the provinces according to national guidelines. Each province has an independent healthcare system and the coverage does vary somewhat between provinces. The Quebec healthcare system is administered by the Regie de l'Assurance Maladie du Québec (RAMQ)

Visitors to Canada are not eligible for coverage by the provincial healthcare plans. All services must be paid for on the spot. It is important to understand this, since hospital fees are due when service is rendered.

Each hospital has a schedule of fees for various services. At a minimum, a visit to the Emergency Room would cost \$680 plus a \$200 fee for the doctor on duty. Diagnostic tests might increase that total. If you are admitted to the hospital, then the daily cost would probably be around \$2300, likely including a request for a three day deposit.

You may already have travel insurance which covers healthcare emergencies. If it does not include direct payment (which it probably does not), you will have to pay for services and get reimbursed later. Most insurances will only pay for you to be stabilized and sent home as fast as possible. If you are traveling in a group, that might be a problem.

Travel insurance for visitors to Canada is available from a variety of suppliers. Some have to be purchased before you travel, and others can be purchased soon after you arrive. Check your coverage before you leave home, and consider personal coverage provided by companies in Canada such as Blue Cross. Search the web for "Travel insurance for visitors to Canada".

Some US insurance companies will only reimburse based on itemized procedure codes listed on the hospital bill. Those codes may not be the same as the ones used in Quebec.

The Quebec healthcare system is world class, but it isn't free. Summer is a difficult time in hospitals with vacations leaving institutions short staffed. Dire emergencies are treated right away. Lesser problems may wait for hours to be seen after triage.

One exception to coverage exclusion for visitors is a traffic accident. If you are injured by a car, you may be covered by Quebec's no-fault auto insurance. If this misfortune happens to you, make sure that there is a police report.

You are not going to need medical care. Think positively! And understand the risk to your wallet.

Canadians from other provinces have a similar problem. They may have to pay for services and then be reimbursed by their provincial healthcare system. In rare circumstances, there may be a reciprocal agreement in place. The fees for Canadians with a provincial medicare card are significantly less than those for visitors from outside Canada. Quebecers with a medicare card do not have to pay any fees for medical services, apart from ambulance fees.

If you use prescription medication, make sure that you bring an adequate supply with you. In Quebec, pharmacists can only fill prescriptions written by a Quebec licensed doctor. Don't put important medications in your checked luggage. Carry them with you.

If you do need to see a doctor, a local walk-in clinic may be a faster and less expensive option. You should have the contact information for your regular family doctor available in case that is requested. There is a walk-in clinic (Centre Médical Le Mesnil) about 10 minutes away by taxi that is accustomed to dealing with travelers from other countries in English.

Some services, such as physiotherapy, are accessible directly without a doctor's prescription.

#### Friendly Change to Family Memberships (and Life Memberships), by Martin Frost

At the March Board meeting, the IJA Board agreed to simplify and limit family dues when multiple family members live at the same location. This will have negligible effect on revenue, while simplifying the renewal process and encouraging members to add more family members as IJA members.

Formerly, an adult member (\$29/year) could add additional family IJA members for \$5/year each. So, for example, two parents and two teenagers would cost \$44/year in membership dues.

Under the new policy, a fixed \$34/year Family Membership can include any number of family members living at one location. The example of two parents and two teenagers now costs only \$34/year (as would a family consisting of two parents, four teenagers and two grandparents).

If your IJA membership already included one or more additional family members, your membership type will have automatically become a Family Membership, as you'll see when it's time to renew (for \$34, no matter how many additional family members your membership includes).

If you want to change from Individual to Family Membership, so that you can include other members of

your family as IJA members, that's easy to do when you *renew*. Just select the Family Membership option in the online renewal form.

To *join* with a Family Membership, a primary family member should be chosen and that person should join with the Family Membership option selected. The primary member can then add family members at no additional cost by logging in at <a href="http://ym.juggle.org">http://ym.juggle.org</a>, clicking on Manage Profile, and then selecting My Family Members.

For Life Members, adding family IJA members is now FREE, as long as they reside with the Life Member. If you're a Life Member and want to add additional family members (for free) under your IJA membership, if you don't see "My Family Members" under Manage Profile, just send a note to <a href="mailto:memberships@juggle.org">memberships@juggle.org</a> requesting to have your Life Membership enabled to include free additional family members.

Individual membership dues and youth membership dues are unchanged at \$29 and \$24 per year, respectively, and life membership is unchanged at \$1250.
