

Legal Matters.

On Sept. 28th, 2009, Judge Toliver issued a letter order to Mr. David Davis advising him that his motion for reargument in the case of Davis V IJA has been denied. Should there be any further developments the IJA Board will issue updates on the status of the case as they occur, including advising of any court rulings.

Although this lawsuit is concluded, under the IJA By-Laws and Roberts Rules of Order, neither the Board Members who were

named as parties nor the current Board Members can comment on the circumstances which gave rise to the lawsuit; and our legal counsel has recommended that the officers, employees and volunteers who were named refrain from offering any comments on the allegations in the complaint or the outcome.
