New Addition to the Performer Lineup, by Erin Stephens

We are excited to announce the addition of a new performer to the already stellar Cascade of Stars cast. Luna Brie Blakeman is known for her fusion of modern dance, traditional circus skills, and musicality within hula-hoop dance. As a coach, she connects with her students through accessible vocabulary, a sense of humor and a serious attitude of positive empowerment.

Luna began her career in 2006, through performing for world-renowned band "The String Cheese Incident", touring across America to high profile music festivals. In 2008 she was hired by Samsung Mobile to perform in India in promotion of the 2008 Olympic Games. In 2011 she co-founded an esteemed circus company in Kansas City Missouri, called "MoonDrop Circus", which is still successful today. The



following year, she was awarded 2012 Hoop Instructor of the Year on Hooping.org, and was recently nominated for "Female Hooper of the Year" in 2013. Every year, in collaboration with her sister, Shakti Sunfire, she hosts the Electric Forest hoop Troupe contest and the annual advanced hula-hoop immersion, called In-Depth in Hawaii.

Over the past year Luna has been training under rhythmic gymnastics coach and Cirque du Soleil performer Rebecca Sukhanova, in Pendulum Aerial Arts' professional track circus program. In this Portland based company, she has studied hand balancing, flex, adagio, and aerial acrobatics. In addition she has been blessed with the opportunity to perform hula-hoop within the professional company. Luna sees the acrobat as a living metaphor, epitomizing true harmony of mind, body and spirit, allowing us space to connect to the inner-self that often gets buried under the tyranny of the everyday. "Circus empowered the part of me that hid silently behind the words, 'I can't', and today it is my mission to carry on this gift to any and all who cross my path." - Luna.

From the Ground Up, by Don Lewis

Circus Oz recently came to Tohu in Montreal. This Australian circus company was founded in 1978 and has been producing successful shows ever since. They like to meld traditional circus skills with contemporary flair, and along the way work collectively on a comfortable scale. They clearly like to have fun since clowning is an important part of the show. And so is live music. Most of the company of about a dozen artists seemed to wind up in the band at various times.

Near the beginning of the show, an audience member was selected to take part in a card trick where he signed his name on a card. Unable to find the signed card when placed in the deck, the hapless magician kept appearing at odd moments throughout the show yelling out "hey, was this your card?".

The principal prop in the show was a wide H-beam which was raised and lowered with chain hoists. It was used as a trapeze support and inclined launch pad for acrobats.

A hanging basket lined with backlit drums swung wildly while the drummer cranked out a rhythm. Acrobats beneath tumbled and rolled to the beat while narrowly avoiding the swinging drummer.

A Chinese pole with a chair fitted to the top proved a challenge because the artist was right up in the lights at the top and had to avoid bumping into things. A grand piano with a lifting hook took to the air along with its pianist for an intense solo. Who knew you could play a piano while swaying in the air? I think it is pretty safe to guess that the keyboard was actually electronic.

There was rolla bolla with several cylinders and a fast paced flying act with a teeter board. A bicycle toured the stage with increasing numbers of people hanging off it. There was dance and acrobatics and clowning while apparatus was being set up. Aerial hoop and trapeze were set up so that



not only could they be raised and lowered, but they could also traverse the stage, giving everyone a good look at the action.

The first juggling action was foot juggling on a chair with Hazel Bock juggling up to five balls back and forth between feet and hands. She finished by manipulating a card table with her feet, turning it over and over and spinning it rapidly. She later juggled up to seven rings and passed clubs.

A clowning segment morphed into some serious juggling. The legs of a four legged stool flew in all directions when sat on. The legs were juggling clubs which the clown who broke the chair proceeded to juggle in various patterns starting with one club and moving smoothly up to four.

The show's theme was construction so naturally there was a segment of a couple of jugglers passing hammers and other tools back and forth during a setup moment. There were a couple of other sequences of serious club passing which wowed the audience. A hat juggling number was a crowd pleaser. It seemed like most of the troupe juggled something at various times throughout the show.

Importantly, all the artists seemed to be having a lot of fun on stage. The whole atmosphere was very relaxed, which seemed to make the "WOW" moments sneak up on you.

At IJA festivals, we see some pretty amazing juggling. This show had its share of hard tricks. But it also demonstrated that really great presentation takes what jugglers think of as basic juggling and turns it into something wonderful to watch.

It was a fun show to see.

Carmagnole Benefit Show, by Don Lewis

Carmagnole is a collective of circus/ carnival artists and social activists in and around Montreal. They want to bring a carnival atmosphere to the masses and expand their network through skill sharing. On the eighth of March, they held a benefit cabaret show at the Plaza Theatre in Montreal. The Plaza is a true cabaret theater with a generously sized stage and a two level area for the audience to sit or stand, and with a full bar service. For this show, the spectators were invited to come in costume. At times it was impossible to discern the performers from the audience in the milling crowd. Clearly this was an audience of enthusiastic partisans. The show was a tribute to International Women's Day earlier in the week. Nearly all of the performers were women.

We saw a full range of performances in widely varied disciplines. There was a hoop hanging from three ropes with a center portion covered by plexiglas. This left the edge of the hoop as a gripping space for some impressive acrobatic transitions from the ropes to the hoop. There was a dynamic breaking segment that proved that the b-girl dancer wasn't giving anything up in moves to her b-boy foil. Regardless of how much break you see in clubs, really good moves on stage that are perfectly executed are a treat to watch. Likewise, hula hoops in the park just don't compare to a well lit, high speed hoop manipulation act. Golden hoops flying around a black costume were changing position so quickly and accurately that I kept asking myself - did I really see that move? A reprise of an act from another recent show was a partially naked girl doing acrobatics on aerial straps in near darkness. Her photographer partner



circled below her with a flash that alternated between single flashes and strobe bursts. A free standing pole was set up right in the middle of the spectator area. The audience got a great view of pole acrobatics by a seriously fit artist dressed in strategically placed colored stickers.

Naturally there was a juggler. Natasha Paterson juggled large red balls and mixed her juggling with fluid contortion. Her five ball cascade seemed effortless even with balls that must have been eight inches in diameter.

There was clowning between the acts, and promotion of Carmagnole's three day festival in August at St-Charles-sur-Richelieu.

After the show, a pair of DJs were prepared to keep the party going. As the night wore on, the organizers were planning an iPod battle before the bar closed at 3:00 am.

Purdue Dorm Room Housing

Entering the IJA Stage Championships

The IJA Stage Championships consist of three events:

1. Individuals – solo juggling routines
2. Teams – routines involving two or more jugglers
3. Juniors – solo juggling routines for jugglers under 18 years old

IJA competitions are open to all, regardless of race, nationality, sex, sexual orientation, or age. The only exception is that entrants in the Juniors event must be under 18 years old on the day of the competition and have neither qualified for nor competed in the Individuals event in past IJA Stage Championships. No one may enter both the Individuals and Juniors events in the same year. No one person may enter as a member of more than one team in any year. Competing in the same year both as a member of a team and as a junior or individual entrant is allowable. All entrants must be IJA members at the time of competition. No team member change (addition, deletion, substitution) is allowed between preliminary competition and final competition.

Applicants must complete three steps by **May 15, 2014**, in order to be considered for the 2014 IJA Stage Championships.

1. Post a video of the proposed routine online (see [Preliminaries](#) for further information).
2. Email championships@juggle.org with the URL of the video and, if necessary, instructions, passwords, or permission to view it. If you are applying to compete as a junior, please also send your date of birth. You must be 17 or younger on July 30, 2014 in order to compete as a junior this year.
3. Pay a \$25 entry fee by check or credit card using Championships Payment Form or by using the IJA Store to buy the Stage Championships Entry Fee (no payment form is required when paying through the IJA Store). The entry fee is \$25 per event. For the Teams competition, the entry fee is \$25 per team (not per person), and only one registration form is needed per team.

Pattern, Trick, and Sequence Creation, by Patrik Elmnert

Tuesday and Wednesday, 10am-12pm – \$60

Jugglers of any skill level, from beginner to expert, are invited to join this special workshop which examines how tricks, patterns, and sequences are created. In this workshop, Patrik will share tools on how to randomly generate juggling tricks, patterns, and sequences on paper that directly translate into juggling. It will be focused on each individual's level and interest within juggling. If you've never made a trick, pattern, or sequence before, this is a great start! The grid you will learn to create will do all the thinking for you. If you've created and composed a lot of juggling in the past, this technique is going to make combinations of throws happen that you wouldn't have imagined before.

Props: Balls, Clubs, and Rings.

Supplies Needed: Pen and Paper.

Take Your Juggling to New Heights, by Richard Kennison

Thursday and Friday, 10am-12pm – \$60

Kellin Quinn, Thom Wall, Tony Pezzo, Ashley Ellis, Book Kennison, Cameron Ritter, Casey Boehmer, and Nate Sorrell — What do these incredible jugglers have in common? They have all been coached and/or trained by Richard Kennison.

In this two day special workshop he will have you look at some of his practical ideas for building a better foundation for your juggling and for creating a juggling act that sets you apart from others.

This workshop is designed for jugglers who have not yet mastered five ball juggling but want to. (Please bring a 48 inch long wooden dowel –quarter sized diameter to this workshop.) Richard does not create juggling robots but helps performers get better at juggling and helps them create the kind of act that is unique to them. Richard is known for meeting jugglers where they are and helping them get going in the direction of where they want to be.

Poi Technique and Exploration, by Cyrille Humen

Wednesday and Thursday, 1pm-3pm – \$60

In this four-hour Special Workshop, Cyrille will present an exploration of various poi techniques including throwing, contact, manipulation, spinning, and more. Flowers, Body Tracing, and Contact Poi techniques will all be covered. Beginning to advanced spinners are welcome.

From clean sequences to chaotic improvisation, participants will search for spontaneous and intuitive movement, shuffle their tricks and experiment with them in order to break out of known patterns and create new ones. Let's get surprised!

2014 IJA Festival Facilities

IJA Festival Venues

The 2014 International Jugglers' Association Festival will be held in West Lafayette, Indiana, on the campus of Purdue University.

Purdue dorm rooms, dining hall meals, and parking permits will all be reserved and paid for through a Purdue University website, which is not yet available. Stay tuned.

Reservations can also be made at several nearby hotels, just a short distance from the campus.

IJA attendees can receive a special discount at the Quality Inn and Suites Hotel. Mention 'jugglers' when making your reservation and receive rooms rates at: \$65 standard / \$89 two room suite. (765) 447-9460. This hotel is 5 miles from Campus and has a shuttle service that runs to Purdue.

There will be free Wi-Fi on most of the campus for registered jugglers — pick up the access code at the IJA table in the gym.

The main festival venues are circled on the Purdue map at the bottom of the page. Here are a list of helpful phone apps you may want to download on your smartphone: Purdue CityBus Tracker, Purdue App (with map), and Purdue University Campus Tour.

The Gym & Workshops will be in the France A. Córdova Recreational Sports Center. This will be the fest's main juggling space and IJA headquarters for the week and will be the location for on-site check-in and registration. The main shows and championships will be held in the evenings at the Loeb Playhouse, located inside the Stewart Center.

Dorms

There are three on-campus housing options including dorm room singles and doubles, with private, shared, or group bathrooms.

Earhart Hall: Double rooms with shared group bathrooms on each floor. Rate: \$30.24 per person per night.





Montreal Juggling Festival - May 2 - 4, 2014, by Don Lewis

The Montreal Juggling Festival is back!

In recent years the Montreal group has struggled with space issues and has been unable to locate a venue that we could afford for a festival. Even a partnership with a local vendor and other groups failed to thrive after the school that had been hosting the festival became permanently unavailable.

Recently, Benoit Ranger of the group Transporteur des Rêves invited us to hold the festival in the nearby town of St. Eustache. There is a huge sports facility available. Initially there was some hesitation on the part of the organizing team. Could we really get a major festival off the ground in a new location on short notice? You can't win if you don't bet, so we're going for it. Everything seems to be falling into place for a great festival with all the familiar features.

There is no shortage of talented jugglers in the area and interest is quickly building in the show. Out-of-town acts are also welcome. Check with [Jean Demarais](#) for more information about performing in the show.

Les Jongleurs Associés du Québec will be joined by local hacky sack enthusiasts and slackliners. There may even be some exciting highline action.


The Multisport Complex in St. Eustache is huge. Even part of it will be more space than we've ever had. It is similar in size to the giant space that the New York festival used at the Pratt Institute in Brooklyn. The ceiling is impressively high at 55 feet. On-site indoor camping will be available in a separate room, with lots of space to set up tents on a soft surface. A snack bar will be available, run by the sports center.

It is easy to get to St. Eustache, which is about 30 minutes by car from Montreal. There is also regular bus service from downtown Montreal, as well as from the Laval METRO terminal. There is plenty of free parking at the sports complex.

The festival is evolving on the JAQ's Facebook page. The JAQ website is currently being renovated, but it will soon have information about the festival.
