The Stevens Center Theater doors will open at 7:30 p.m. for tonight's 8pm show. Arrive on time, as Show Director Dan Holzman has an amazing lineup of acts, including the U.S. debut of Team RdL and the IJA debut of Florent Lestage. The 2009 IJA Teams Champion Sharpe Brothers are hosting.

The Stevens Center Theater is one block from the gym. Head south on Marshall Street to 4th Street, and the theater will be on your right.
