YOU'VE COME A LONG WAY, BABY

Hanes Park Track, Winston-Salem (July 14) – When the medals were handed out in the gym, the star jugglers of 2009 were clear. The top men were collegiate trackers and first-time festival juggler Tyler Wishau of Columbia, MO, and 15-year old speedster David Ferman of Jacksonville, FL. A larger-than-usual field of eight female jugglers was led to the finish most often by veteran juggler Heather Marriott of Prescott, AZ and 17-year old Jughead juggler Amanda Richter. Wisau won eight gold medals and one silver. Ferman had the best time of the day in both the 100-meter three-ball (13.91 seconds) and the 100-meter five-ball (22.6 seconds). More than 35 of the 42 total entrants ended up winning a first, second, or third-place medal for their participation in seven individual and two relay events, ranging from 100 meters to 5k.
